

Corflute Signs Flute Direction

VERTICAL FLUTE



if using metal stands/spikes

Notes

Flute direction

Flute direction is particularly important for this size sign in case you are planning to use ground spikes with the order, if this is the case you will required vertical flutes. If this is not the case and you do not have a preference, we will print as per the greatest yield.

Election signage

Flute direction is particularly important when the signs are attached to telegraph poles or vertical posts. In this case the flutes need to run horizontally to provide horizontal strength and ensure the signs do not "wrap" around the post in strong winds.

NOTE: If your signage includes eyelets, flute direction may not be important.
