

# Crowd Control Barriers

## Care Sheet

### Cleaning

We recommend that the Crowd Control Barrier is cleaned regularly. To clean the Crowd Control Barrier use a mild detergent in warm water with a soft mop or cloth. It is important to note that no solvents or abrasive cleaners should be used on any part of the Crowd Control Barrier. To avoid the growth of mildew it is important that the Crowd Control Barrier is completely dry before being packed away.

### Maintenance

Make sure that you assemble the Crowd Control Barrier correctly in accordance with our assembly guide and that:

- All screws are intact and tight
- All poles have been inserted into the correct pole (with the same symbol)
- All poles have been clicked into the next pole correctly
- The Crowd Control Barrier has been zipped up at the bottom

### General Use

The Crowd Control Barrier should not be used outdoors unless you have safely secured it to avoid it being blown over. They should not be used in windy conditions.
